

April 2018



Ann Arbor's seasonal curbside compost collection program for 2018 begins on Monday, April 2 with weekly pickups of paper yard waste bags, compost carts and bundled brush, on normal solid waste collection days.

Curbside compost collection ends for the season on Friday, December 7, 2018.

Compost carts are an optional container managed by the City of Ann Arbor. The carts are available for purchase and pickup at the City Hall Customer Service Center, 301 E. Huron Street, 1st floor. Hours are Monday through Friday, 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. If you have questions, please contact the city's Customer Service Center via email customer-service@a2gov.org or phone at 734.794.6320.

A compost cart is required if used for storing grass clippings, plate scrapings, fruit and vegetable scraps and leaves.

Compost carts cost \$25 and are available in 64 and 96-gallon sizes.

Each additional cart costs \$50 per year/per household.



Paper yard waste bags and bundled brush may also be used for yard waste.

*Carts must not exceed 224 pounds for the 64-gallon, 112 pounds for the 32-gallon or 336 pounds for the 96-gallon size. Carts over the limit will not be serviced.

- 1. ALLIUM 'PURPLE SENSATION' (Ornamental Onion)-30" tall; blooms in early summer; violet baseball-sized blooms.
- CHIONODOXA F. 'PINK GIANT' (Glory of the Snow)- 8" tall; blooms in early spring; pink with a white center.
- 3. HYACINTHA 'CITY OF HAARLEM' (Hyacinth)- 10" tall; blooms early-mid spring; soft primrose yellow.
- H. 'DELFT BLUE'- 10" tall; blooms early-mid spring; soft lilac blue.

- 6. H. 'JAN BOS'- 10" tall; blooms early-mid spring; brilliant cerise.
 - 7. IRIS R. 'JS DIJT' (Dwarf Iris)- 6" tall; blooms early-mid spring; reddish purple.
- *8. MUSCARI 'VALERIE FINNIS' (Grape Hyacinth)-8" tall; blooms mid spring; pale lavender blue.
 - 9. NARCISSUS 'BABY BOOMER' (Miniature Daffodil)-8" tall; blooms mid spring; yellow with small orange cup; fragrant.
- 10. NARCISSUS 'BABY MOON' (Miniature Daffodil)-8" tall; blooms late spring; golden yellow; grassy foliage; fragrant.
- 11. N. 'CEYLON' (Large Cup Daffodil)- 16" tall; blooms early-mid spring; buttercup yellow with a red-orange cup.
- 12. N. 'DECOY' (Large Cup Daffodil)-16" tall; blooms late spring; white with a deep rose cup.
- 13. N. 'FLOWER RECORD' (Large Cup Daffodil)-16" tall; blooms late spring; white with a yellow cup edged in red.
- 14. N. 'HAWERA' (Miniature Daffodil)- 6" tall; blooms mid-late spring; pale yellow with swept back petals.
- 15. N. 'HIGH SOCIETY' (Large Cup Daffodil)- 18" tall; blooms late spring; ivory with a yellow and pink cup (one of my favorite daffo

- 米 16. N. 'MERLIN' (Small Cup Daffodil)- 16" tall; blooms late spring; white with a small, red-rimmed yellow cup.
- 17. N. 'PROTOTYPE' (Cyclamineus Daffodil)-14" tall; blooms mid spring; pale yellow with pink cup.
- CHURCHHILL' (Double Daffodil)-16" tall; blooms late-mid spring; double cream flowers with orange
- 19. N. 'TETE-A-TETE' (Miniature Daffodil)- 6" tall; blooms early spring; buttercup yellow.
- 20. TULIPA 'BALLADE' (Lily-Flowered Tulip)- 22" tall; blooms late spring; reddish magenta with white edges.
- 21. T. 'BALLERINA' (Lily-Flowered Tulip)- 20" tall; blooms late spring; stunning orange-yellow and red exterior; marigold or ange interior.
 - 22. T. 'CYNTHIA' (Species Tulip)- 10" tall; blooms mid spring; red petals edged w/ chartreuse; purple base (Hove this one!)
- 23. T. 'DORDOGNE' (Single Late Tulip)- 24" tall; blooms late spring; rose and yellow exterior; red interior.
- 24. T. LILAC WONDER (Species Tulip)-7" tall; blooms mid spring; rose lavender with a yellow heart.
- 25. T. MARIANNE (Lily-Flowered Tulip)- 20" tall; blooms late spring; rosy raspberry and yellow.
- 26. T. MARILYN (Lily-Flowered Tulip)-18" tall; blooms late spring; white with luscious raspberry swirls.
- 27. T. PERSIAN PEARL (Species Tulip)- 4" tall; blooms early-mid spring; magenta rose with yellow heart.
- T. PRINCESS IRENE (Triumph Tulip)-14" tall; blooms mid spring; bright tangerine with purple streaks.
- 29. T. TINKA (Species Tulip)- 10" tall; blooms late-mid spring; red outer; primrose yellow interior.
