City of Ann Arbor Update:
Winter Composting Program to
Resume for 2023

Regular weekly compost collections in the city of Ann Arbor will end for the year on Friday, Dec. 9, 2022. The city will then switch gears to resume once-monthly winter collection of food scraps in compost carts beginning the first full week of January and lasting through March. Specifically, winter compost collections will occur the weeks of Jan. 2, Feb. 6 and March 6.


City of Ann Arbor Update: Christmas Tree Drop-off Sites Open in Ann Arbor Dec. 12—Jan. 16

Drop-off locations for free Christmas tree disposal will be open for Ann Arbor residents at designated spots in four city parks Monday, Dec. 12 - Monday, Jan. 16, 2023. The four park locations will be open for Christmas tree drop offs during normal park hours, 6 a.m.— 10 p.m. The collected trees will be chipped on a regular basis at the park sites. The drop-off locations are:

- •Southeast Area Park located on Ellsworth at Platt. Trees may be left at the dirt lot north of the basketball courts.
- •West Park parking lot off Chapin near West Huron Street.
- •Gallup Boat Launch parking lot (not the Gallup Livery), entrance on the southeast side of Geddes Road, East of Huron Parkway.
- •Olson Park parkin g lot, 1515 Dhu Varren Road, near Pontiac Trail.

Because the trees will be chipped into mulch, all lights, ornaments, stands, etc. must be removed prior to drop off, as these items could damage equipment and, most importantly, harm the operators.

For Our Snow Birds

If you are going to be away for an extended period during the winter season around the corner, you will find that you have a bit more prepping & planning to do before you depart. We caution you that you will be responsible for all damages which <u>may occur as a result of failure to maintain heat and electricity at the unit.</u>

Use this checklist of winterization steps to secure your home before you leave

- **Keep heat set above 60 degrees** (or at temperature outlined in Bylaws as applicable) and open cabinets containing pipes to allow heat to enter.
- Do not shut off basic utilities (electric, heat or water).
- Secure all windows and locks.
- Provide a neighbor with a key and notify Management (office@pittsfieldvillage.com) who has it.
- Email management (office@pittsfieldvillage.com) with emergency contact info so that we can contact you or your designated emergency contact in an emergency situation.
- Ask a friend, neighbor or family member to inspect the interior of your unit periodically for any signs of a problem if you are not routinely available to perform these inspections yourself.
- Stop deliveries and forward mail so that it is not obvious that the unit is vacant.
